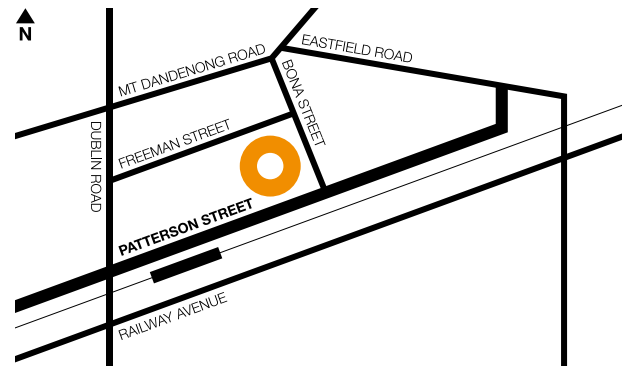

Kindergarten programs are embedded within the long day care. There are no additional fees to access funded 4 year old or 3 year old Kindergarten programs.
