This payment is to cover non-ongoing costs for EACH establishing arrangements and assisting Customers in implementing their plan. The establishment fee is claimable by the provider who assists the Customer with the implementation of their NDIS Plan, delivers a minimum of 20 hours per month of personal care/community access support and has made an agreement with the Customer to supply these services. A budget of \$750 is included in the first Plan for NDIS Customers in case they need to this type of assistance from providers to design and implement support arrangements.</p>	<p>The establishment fee will operate as follows:</p> <p>EACH can charge \$500 against a plan if assisting a new Customer, who is new to NDIS and new to EACH.</p> <p>EACH can charge \$250 he participant is an existing EACH Customer but new to the NDIS.</p> <p>If a Customer wishes to change providers, \$250 is available to the new provider. This is to assist the Customer in changing providers.</p>

From 1 July 2020, the changes to establishment fee rules mean that a provider can only claim an establishment fee ONCE per participant across all plans. Establishment fees will now be calculated at up to ten times the hourly weekday daytime price limit for a Level 1 Disability Support Worker. For example, using the 2019-2020 price limits, the maximum fee would be \$528.50. Previously, the fee was based on a flat fee structure of between \$250-500.

Providers of personal care, community access or employment supports can claim this fee once for participants they support at least 20 hours a month for three or more consecutive months. Note that employment supports is a new addition to that list.

Providers in the following registration groups will be able to start charging the establishment fee:

- 0104 High Intensity Daily Personal Activities
- 0125 Participation in community, social and civic activities
- 0136 Group and Centre Based Activities.

In addition to the above registration groups, 0107 Daily Personal Activities will continue to be able to charge establishment fees.

Provider Travel

EACH may claim travel costs when travelling to and from appointments to deliver Core and Capacity Building Supports. This includes the cost of the staff members time and any additional costs such as mileage, parking fees, tolls etc

Travel for EACH to provide Capacity Building Supports (Support Coordination, Recovery Coach)

EACH will charge Provider Travel costs only when:

- EACH has the agreement of the Customer in advance i.e. the Quote outlines all maximum Provider Travel costs that may be charged;
- The Support Catalogue indicates that EACH can claim for Provider Travel in respect of that support item;
- EACH is required to pay the worker delivering the support for the time they spent travelling as a result of the agreement under which the worker is employed;
- For travel to a first Customer appointment each day (if leaving from the office); and
- For travel from one Customer appointment to another; and
- For travel from the last Customer of the day back to the office (from the Customer's home to the usual place of work).

EACH will claim UP TO 30 minutes of time when delivering Capacity Building Supports in a MMM1, MMM2 or MMM3 area against the appointment we are travelling to (first Customer of day, between consecutive

If the appointment is in a MMM4 or MMM5 we will claim up to 60 minutes of travel time in rural areas, against the appointment we are travelling to (first Customer of day, between consecutive Customers and the last

In remote areas MMM6 and MMM7, EACH will enter specific arrangements with Customers to cover travel costs, up to the relevant hourly rate for the support item. EACH will endeavour to minimise the travel costs

Travel for EACH to provide Core Supports

EACH will charge Provider Travel costs for services delivered under the following Core Support Categories only:

- Assistance with Daily Life (includes Supported Independent Living (Category 1)
- Assistance with Social & Community Participation (Category 4)

Where EACH intends to claim travel costs to provide Core Supports to a Customer, we must specify the travel charges that EACH will claim from the NDIS plan in the quote.

EACH must quote for Provider Travel against Category 1 and 4 line items:

- the Support Catalogue indicates that EACH can claim for Provider Travel in respect of that support item;
- EACH is required to pay the worker delivering the support for the time they spent travelling;
- For each shift of Core Supports delivered where a Support Worker travels from one Customer appointment to another.

EACH will not charge travel costs:

- For travel for the time that a Support Worker spends travelling from home to the workplace (to a first Customer appointment each day); or
- For travel from the workplace to home (the last Customer appointment of the day)

Where a Support Worker travels from one Customer appointment to another, up to 30 minutes of time can be claimed (therefore should be quoted) in a MMM1, MMM2 or MMM3 area, against the next appointment at

Where a worker travels from one Customer appointment to another in an MMM4 or MMM5 area, up to 60 minutes of time can be claimed (therefore should be quoted) against the next appointment at the hourly rate

Quotes must be developed based the Modified Monash Model (MMM).

Modified Monash Model

The Modified Monash Model (MMM) is a recently developed geographical classification system, using up-to-date population data, which the Government can use to better address the maldistribution of medical services across Australia.

EACH use the workforce locator map to check the geographical classification of any location in Australia and to develop your quote. The map can tell you if a location is classified as city, rural or remote. It identifies areas that need more doctors.
