Establishment Fee

Establishment Fee for Personal Care/Participation is claimable by EACH when we assist the Customer (as outlined in their Service Agreement) with the implementation of their NDIS Plan and deliver a minimum of 20 hours per month of personal care/community access support for 3 or more consecutive months.

This payment is to cover non-claimable costs for EACH establishing arrangements and assisting Customers in implementing their plan.

Providers in the following registration groups can charge the establishment fee:

- Personal Care Supports - supports in the Activities of Daily Living Support Category (CAT 1) that are delivered by providers with these Registration Groups:

- Daily Personal Activities (0107); or
- High Intensity Daily Personal Activities (0104); or

- Participation Supports - supports in the Social, Economic and Community Participation (CAT 4) Support Category delivered by providers with these Registration Groups:

- Participation in Community, Social and Civic Activities (0125); or
- Group and Centre Based Activities (0136); or
- High Intensity Daily Personal Activities (0104) when delivered for community access or group supports;

EACH can only claim an Establishment Fee in respect of a Customer ONCE ACROSS ALL PLANS. If EACH delivers services to a Customer through more than one Registration Group or more than one Support Category we can only claim for one Establishment Fee. More than one provider is able to claim an Establishment Fee against a given plan as long as each provider meets the relevant requirements.

Provider Travel

EACH may claim travel costs when travelling to and from appointments to deliver Core and Capacity Building Supports. This includes the cost of the staff members time and any additional costs such as mileage, parking fees, tolls etc

Travel for EACH to provide Capacity Building Supports AND/OR Core Supports

EACH will charge Provider Travel costs at the value of the service delivered (time) plus at \$1.00 per kilometre (mileage) only when:

- EACH explains the value of these activities to the Customer has the agreement of the Customer in advance i.e. the Quote outlines all maximum Provider Travel costs that may be charged;
- The proposed charges for the activities comply with the NDIS Pricing Arrangements and Price Limits which also indicates that EACH can claim for Provider Travel in respect of that support item;
- EACH is required to pay the worker delivering the support for the time they spent travelling as a result of the agreement under which the worker is employed;
- The activities are part of delivering a specific face to face disability support item to that Customer;
- For travel to a Customer appointment; and
- For travel from one Customer appointment to another; and
- For travel from the Customer back to the office the staff member is employed by (when this occurs). This travel is only claimable when EACH must pay our worker for the return travel time.

EACH will claim UP TO 30 minutes of time when delivering Capacity Building Supports or Core Supports in a MMM1, MMM2 or MMM3 area against the appointment we are travelling to (from office to Customer, between consecutive Customers, any return trip to the office), at the hourly rate for the relevant support item.

If the appointment is in a MMM4 or MMM5 we will claim up to 60 minutes of travel time in rural areas, against the appointment we are travelling to (from office to Customer, between consecutive Customers, any return trip to the office), at the hourly rate for the relevant support item.

In remote areas MMM6 and MMM7, EACH will enter specific arrangements with Customers to cover travel costs, up to the relevant hourly rate for the support item. EACH will endeavour to minimise the travel costs that Customers need to pay (e.g. co-ordinating appointments with other Customers in an area, so that travel costs can be shared between Customers).

EACH will charge Provider Travel costs for services delivered under the following Core Support Categories only:

- Assistance with Daily Life (includes Supported Independent Living (Category 1)

Provider Travel can not be claimed against Category 2 or Category 3 activity.
